**An Act to amend the Judicature Act 1908**

[28 July 1988]

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Judicature Amendment Act 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Judicature Act 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1989.

**2. New section inserted**—The principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after section 16, the following section:

**“16A. Power to award damages as well as, or in substitution for, injunction or specific performance**—Where the Court has jurisdiction to entertain an application for an injunction or specific performance, it may award damages in addition to, or in substitution for, an injunction or specific performance.”
