Title. AN ACT to amend the Land and Income Assessment Acts.
[22nd December, 1897.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title. 1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Land and Income Assessment Acts Amendment Act, 1897.”

License-fee for non-resident agents abolished. 2. Subsections two to eight of section five of “The Land and Income Assessment Acts Amendment Act, 1895,” as also the regulations for the purpose of giving effect to those subsections, are hereby repealed.
