**An Act to amend the Lincoln College Act 1961**

[2 September 1966

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Lincoln College Amendment Act 1966, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Lincoln College Act 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Employees as Council members**—Section 9 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from the second proviso to subsection (1) the words “four hundred pounds”, and substituting the words “seven hundred and fifty pounds”.

**3. Election of Council members**—Section 13 of the principal Act is hereby amended, as from its commencement, by inserting in subsection (2), after the words “shall be conducted”, the words “and determined”.

**4. Application of income of College**—Section 38 of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding, as subsection (2), the following subsection:

“(2) Without limiting the generality of the foregoing provisions of this section it is hereby declared that the Council may from time to time, out of income which may be applied in accordance with those provisions, create, maintain, and add to a fund or funds for any one or more of the purposes for which that income may be applied.”
