| <p>Title.</p>   | <p style="text-align: center;">AN ACT to amend "The Legislative Council Act, 1891."<br/> <span style="float: right;">[3rd October, 1902.]</span></p> <p>BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—</p>   |
| <p>Short Title.</p>   | <p>1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Legislative Council Act Amendment Act, 1902"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Legislative Council Act, 1891."</p>   |
| <p>Speaker's term of office extended in certain cases.</p>              | <p>2. Where the term of office of the Speaker of the Council expires when Parliament is not in session, he shall, subject to the provisions of "The Legislative Council Act, 1891," continue to hold office until fourteen days after the commencement of the next ensuing session, or until the election of his successor, whichever first happens.</p> |
| <p>Continuity of office of Speaker and Chairman.</p>                    | <p>3. Where the seat of a member of the Council becomes vacant by effluxion of time during the currency of his term of office as Speaker or Chairman of Committees and he is forthwith reappointed member of the Council, such term of office shall continue in like manner as if such vacancy had not occurred.</p>                                     |
| <p>Chairman of Committees to act as Speaker on a vacancy occurring.</p> | <p>4. Where the office of Speaker of the Council becomes vacant, the Chairman of Committees for the time being or the last elected Chairman of Committees shall (except as to salary) have all the powers, rights, and privileges of the Speaker until the election of a Speaker.</p>  |
| <p>Repeal.</p>  | <p>5. "The Legislative Council Act Amendment Act, 1897," is hereby repealed.</p>   |
