An Act to amend the Land Drainage Act 1908

[8 December 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Land Drainage Amendment Act 1971, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Land Drainage Act 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Annual allowance to Chairman—(1) Section 11A of the principal Act (as inserted by section 16 of the Statutes Amendment Act 1950 and amended by section 2 (1) of the Land Drainage Amendment Act 1968) is hereby further amended by omitting from subsection (1) the words “two hundred dollars”, and substituting the expression “\$250”.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in section 11A of the principal Act (as amended by subsection (1) of this section), the allowance of the Chairman of any Board who is in office at the date of the passing of this Act may, by resolution of the Board passed within 6 months after that date, be increased once during his term of office.

(3) Section 2 of the Land Drainage Amendment Act 1968 is hereby consequentially repealed.

3. Remuneration of members—Section 13B of the principal Act (as inserted by section 3 of the Land Drainage Amendment Act 1968) is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting the words “the rate of three dollars”, and substituting the words “a rate fixed by the Board not exceeding \$5”:
- (b) By omitting from the proviso the words “one hundred and fifty-six dollars”, and substituting the expression “\$260”.
