Title.

AN ACT to amend the Local Elections and Polls Act, 1908.

[28th October, 1911.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Elections and Polls Amendment Act, 1911.

Voters in polling-booth at close of poll to be allowed to vote.

2. Section seventeen of the Local Elections and Polls Act, 1908, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection:—

“(2.) Every elector who on the close of the poll is present in a polling-booth for the purpose of voting shall be entitled to receive a voting-paper, and to mark and deposit it in the same manner as if he had voted before the close of the poll.”
