An Act to amend the Local Government Act 1974

[28 July 1997]

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Local Government Amendment Act 1997, and is part of the Local Government Act 1974 (“the principal Act”).

2. Interpretation—(1) Section 2 (1) of the principal Act is amended by repealing the definition of the term “region” (as substituted by section 2 (6) of the Local Government Act 1992), and substituting the following definition:

“‘Region’ means a region in respect of which—

“(a) A regional council is constituted; or

“(b) A territorial authority has, pursuant to section 37N, authority to exercise the functions, duties, and powers of a regional council:”.

(2) Section 2 (6) of the Local Government Amendment Act 1992 is consequentially repealed.
