An Act to amend the Licensing Trusts Act 1949

[16 December 1988]

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Licensing Trusts Amendment Act 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Licensing Trusts Act 1949 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Remuneration of Chairman and travelling expenses of Chairman and members—Section 8 of the principal Act (as substituted by section 2(1) of the Licensing Trusts Amendment Act 1969) is hereby amended by repealing subsection (2).

3. Remuneration of members—(1) The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing section 8A (as substituted by section 2 of the Licensing Trusts Amendment Act 1985), and substituting the following section:

“8A. The Trust may pay to each of its members, other than the Chairman, in respect of each meeting of the Trust or of any committee of the Trust attended by that member, remuneration at a rate fixed by the Trust not exceeding \$50, but no more than \$2,500 in total in any financial year.”

(2) The Licensing Trusts Amendment Act 1985 is hereby consequentially repealed.

(3) Subsections (1) and (2) of this section shall be deemed to have come into force on the 11th day of December 1987.
