An Act to amend the Lake Wanaka Preservation Act 1973

[16 December 1988]

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Lake Wanaka Preservation Amendment Act (No. 2) 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Lake Wanaka Preservation Act 1973 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Guardians of Lake Wanaka—Section 5 of the principal Act is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from subsection (1) the word “he”, and substituting the words “the Minister”; and
- (b) By omitting from subsection (2) (b) (iii) the word “him”, and substituting the words “the Minister”.

3. Harbour works on lake restricted—The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing section 11, and substituting the following section:

“11. (1) The Minister of Conservation shall not approve any plan deposited pursuant to section 178 (1) (a) of the Harbours Act 1950 in respect of any harbour works, pipelines, cables, or other structure of any kind to be undertaken or constructed on, in, over, through, or across the lake without first—

- “(a) Seeking the advice of the Guardians of Lake Wanaka on the proposed work concerned, and considering all advice received from them within a reasonable time of its being sought; and

“(b) Having regard to the purposes of this Act.

“(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not derogate from or otherwise affect section 178 (2) of the Harbours Act 1950.”

This Act is administered in the Department of Conservation.
