An Act to amend the Maori Education Foundation Act 1961

[6 December 1962]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Maori Education Foundation Amendment Act 1962, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Maori Education Foundation Act 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Administration—(1) Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from the definition of the term “financial year” the word “March”, and substituting the word “December”.

(2) Section 8 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after subsection (3), the following subsection:

“(3A) In the absence from any meeting of any member appointed under subparagraph (i), subparagraph (ii), or subparagraph (iii) of paragraph (e) of subsection (2) of this section, he may, with the approval of the persons by whom or the organisation by which he was nominated, authorise any other person to attend that meeting in his stead. Any

person who attends any meeting of the Board pursuant to this subsection shall for the purposes of that meeting be deemed to be a member of the Board.”

3. Life membership of Foundation—(1) Subsection (1) of section 6 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing paragraph (b), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(b) All persons who are for the time being accepted by the Board as life members or provisional life members of the Foundation.”

(2) Section 6 of the principal Act is hereby further amended by repealing subsection (2), and substituting the following subsections:

“(2) The Board may accept as a life member of the Foundation any person who gives to the funds of the Foundation an amount of not less than twenty pounds in one or more donations, or who makes a gift to the Foundation of other property of a value of not less than twenty pounds.

“(2A) The Board may accept as a provisional life member of the Foundation any person who makes an initial donation to the funds of the Foundation of an amount of not less than two pounds and who undertakes to make further regular donations of not less than two pounds so as to make his total donations not less than twenty pounds in a period of ten years or less from the date of his initial donation.

“(2B) If any person accepted as a provisional life member fails to carry out the undertaking referred to in subsection (2A) of this section, the Board may cancel its acceptance and, in any such case, that person shall no longer be deemed to be a provisional life member.”

This Act is administered in the Department of Education.
