An Act to amend the Masterton Licensing Trust Act 1947

[6 November 1986]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Masterton Licensing Trust Amendment Act 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Masterton Licensing Trust Act 1947 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Fees—(1) Section 32 of the principal Act (as substituted by section 13 of the Licensing Trusts Amendment Act 1962) is hereby amended by omitting from subsection (6) (as amended by section 10 of the Licensing Trusts Amendment Act 1964) the words “exceeding the maximum fee that may be fixed for a booth licence under paragraph (j) of subsection (2) of section 286 of the Sale of Liquor Act 1962”, and substituting the words “being more than the prescribed amount for each day in respect of which the permit is granted”.

(2) Section 36 (1) of the principal Act (as substituted by section 28 (1) of the Licensing Trusts Amendment Act 1975) is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$50”, and substituting the words “the prescribed amount”.
