**An Act to amend the Marine Pollution Act 1974**

[9 October 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Marine Pollution Amendment Act 1975, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marine Pollution Act 1974 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Compulsory insurance for ships**—Section 37 (1) (a) of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, before the word “oil” wherever it occurs, the word “persistent”.

**3. Certificates**—Section 38 (4) of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following proviso:

“Provided that the Minister may in his discretion accept a certificate in such form as the Minister thinks fit from the person providing the insurance or other financial security as to the existence of a contract of insurance or other financial security or, as the case may be, as to any variation or modification thereof or thereto instead of notarially certified copies of the contract of insurance or security or variation or modification.”
