AN ACT to amend the Military Training Act 1949.

Title.

[30 April 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Military Training Amendment Act 1953, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Military Training Act 1949 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and fifty-three.

2. (1) This section applies to every male British subject who at any time after the first day of November, nineteen hundred and forty-nine, whether before or after the commencement of this Act, has become ordinarily resident in New Zealand after having attained the age of eighteen years but before attaining the age of twenty-one years, not being—

Liability for service of men becoming ordinarily resident in New Zealand between eighteen and twenty-one years of age.

(a) A person specified in section five of the principal Act; or

(b) A person already subject to registration; or

(c) A person born before the first day of November, nineteen hundred and thirty.

(2) Subject to the provisions of this section, every person to whom this section applies shall be liable to be called upon to serve in the armed forces to the same extent as if he had always been ordinarily resident in New Zealand, and the principal Act, as far as it is applicable and with the necessary modifications, shall apply accordingly.

(3) Every person to whom this section applies shall become subject to registration on the date on which he becomes ordinarily resident in New Zealand:

Provided that every such person who has become ordinarily resident in New Zealand before the date of the commencement of this Act shall become subject to registration on that date.
