- Title.** AN ACT to empower the Napier City Council to raise a loan or loans for the purpose of constructing and improving streets in that part of the City of Napier known as Westshore. [1 December 1951
- Preamble.** WHEREAS a petition was presented to the Governor-General under section one hundred and thirty-six of the Municipal Corporations Act 1933 praying that the area referred to in that petition, being part of the County of Hawke's Bay, should be excluded from that County and included in the Borough of Napier: And whereas by Order in Council dated the twenty-sixth day of November, nineteen hundred and forty-one, and published in the *Gazette* of the fourth day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-one, Volume III, at page 3840, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Municipal Corporations Act 1933 and section twenty of the Local Legislation Act 1941, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, declared that as on and from the first day of April, nineteen hundred and forty-two, the area described in the Schedule to the said Order in Council (hereinafter referred to as the Westshore Area) should

be excluded from the County of Hawke's Bay and included in the Borough of Napier: And whereas by Proclamation issued pursuant to section one hundred and thirty-four of the Municipal Corporations Act 1933, published in the *Gazette* of the ninth day of March, nineteen hundred and fifty, Volume I, at page 244, the Governor-General proclaimed the Borough of Napier to be a city as on and from the eighteenth day of March, nineteen hundred and fifty: And whereas the streets in the Westshore Area have been constructed to County standards only: And whereas the Napier City Council (hereinafter referred to as the Council) is desirous of carrying out in the Westshore Area certain works as hereinafter mentioned in order to bring the said streets up to borough standards, and it is expedient that the Council be given the loan authority hereinafter created:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Napier City (Westshore Streets Improvement) Empowering Act 1951.

2. For the purpose of enabling the Council to carry out works comprising the construction, surfacing, sealing, kerbing, and channelling of streets and footpaths and the provision of covered storm-water drains in the Westshore Area, and to contribute towards the cost of similar works on that portion of the Gisborne-Napier State Highway which is on the boundary of the Westshore Area, the Council is hereby authorized and empowered to raise, by special order or special orders, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate seventy-seven thousand six hundred pounds, by way of special loan or loans under the provisions of the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, without taking the steps prescribed by sections nine to thirteen of that Act, such special loan or loans to be secured by a special rate or rates to be made and levied over the whole of the rateable property in the City of Napier.
