

AN ACT to amend "The Nelson Waste Lands Act 1863." Title.
[12th September 1870.]

WHEREAS an Act was passed by the General Assembly of New Zealand intituled "The Nelson Waste Lands Act 1863" and whereas it is expedient that the said Act should be amended Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Nelson Waste Lands Act Amendment Act 1870." Short Title.

2. Clause seventy of the said recited Act is hereby repealed.

Clause 70 of recited Act repealed.

3. It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands at any time if he shall think fit to withhold from sale any land which shall be applied for under the thirty-second or thirty-fifth section of the said recited Act. Commissioner may withhold land from sale.

4. Whenever any land shall be so withheld the Commissioner shall summon a meeting of the Waste Lands Board to be held within three days thereafter who shall decide whether such land shall be sold or reserved for any or either of the purposes mentioned in the said recited Act. Board may make reserves.

5. It shall be lawful for the Waste Lands Board if they shall think fit to issue timber licenses to any persons authorizing them to cut timber upon any Waste Lands of the Crown specified therein not exceeding ten acres for the term of one year on payment of a fee of five pounds for every such license Provided that gold miners requiring timber for their own use and persons holding business licenses shall not be required to take out a license to cut such timber as aforesaid. Timber licenses may be issued.

Nelson Waste Lands Act Amendment.

Flax licenses &c. may
be issued.

6. It shall also be lawful for the Waste Lands Board if they shall think fit to issue licenses to any persons authorizing them to cut flax upon any Waste Lands of the Crown specified therein not exceeding five hundred acres in any one such license for any term not exceeding seven years and to issue leases for a like period of sites for the erection of buildings and machinery and for drying grounds not exceeding ten acres in any one lease upon such terms and conditions as the Board shall think expedient.
