2. Extension of time within which students of architecture may be registered without examination.

AN ACT to amend the New Zealand Institute of Architects Act, 1913. Title.
[5th November, 1919.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Institute of Architects Amendment Act, 1919, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the New Zealand Institute of Architects Act, 1913 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

2. With respect to any member of an Expeditionary Force under the Expeditionary Forces Act, 1915, who has served beyond New Zealand, the period limited by paragraphs (f) and (g) of section eight of the principal Act within which application for registration is required to be made is hereby extended to the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty. Extension of time within which students of architecture may be registered without examination.
