An Act to amend "The New Zealand University Act, 1874." Title. [28th July, 1883.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The New Zealand University Short Title.

Act 1874 Amendment Act, 1883."

2. The Senate of the University of New Zealand shall have Degrees may be power, after examination, to confer the several degrees of Bachelor Law, Medicine, and Master in Arts, and Bachelor and Doctor in Law, Medicine, Science, and Music, and such reasonable fees shall be charged for the degrees so conferred as the Senate shall from time to time direct.
