AN ACT to authorize the Municipal Council of the Incorporated Town of Oamaru to raise Money for the purpose of completing the Waterworks for the Supply of the Town with Water.

OAMARU WATER-
WORKS ACT 1875
AMENDMENT.

[17th October, 1878.]

WHEREAS by the provisions of "The Oamaru Waterworks Act, 1875," the Municipal Council of the incorporated Town of Oamaru was authorized to borrow sixty thousand pounds for the purpose of supplying the Town of Oamaru with water, provided that the said money should not be raised until the undertaking should have become a duly authorized undertaking within the provisions of "The Municipal Corporations Waterworks Act, 1872:" And whereas the said "Municipal Corporations Waterworks Act, 1872," was brought into operation in and for the Town of Oamaru by an Ordinance of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of Otago, shortly intituled "The Oamaru Waterworks Empowering Ordinance, 1875:" And whereas all the conditions in that behalf having been complied with, George Turnbull, Esquire, then Deputy Superintendent of the Province of Otago, did, by Proclamation dated at Dunedin, on the twelfth day of October, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on the twenty-eighth day of October,

one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, notify that the undertaking would be carried out under the provisions of "The Municipal Corporations Waterworks Act, 1872," and the said undertaking thereupon became a duly authorized undertaking within the meaning of the said Act: And whereas the sum of sixty thousand pounds has, in pursuance of "The Oamaru Waterworks Act, 1875," been borrowed, and a contract duly entered into for the carrying out of such undertaking, but the said sum of money has been found insufficient to provide for the purchase of the property required, and for the completion of the works necessary to provide for the supply of water to the ratepayers of the town, who are now liable to pay the special rate of one shilling and threepence in the pound leviable under the provisions of "The Municipal Corporations Waterworks Act, 1872:" And whereas it is expedient that further powers be conferred upon the said Council for the completion of the said waterworks, and that the said Act should be amended:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Oamaru Waterworks Act 1875 Amendment Act, 1878."

Special loan authorized.

2. For the purpose of completing the construction of the said waterworks, the Municipal Council of Oamaru may borrow such sums as may be requisite, by way of special loan, in manner provided by "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876."
