An Act to amend the Parliamentary Commissioner (Ombudsman) Act 1962 [23 November 1967]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary Commissioner (Ombudsman) Amendment Act 1967, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Parliamentary Commissioner (Ombudsman) Act 1962 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.

2. Salary of Commissioner—(1) Section 7 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsections (1) and (2), and substituting the following subsection:

“(1) There shall be paid to the Commissioner out of the Consolidated Revenue Account, without further appropriation than this section, a salary at the following rates:

“(a) During the year ending with the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, at the rate of nine thousand and forty dollars a year:

“(b) On and after the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, at the rate of nine thousand six hundred dollars a year.”

(2) The Ombudsman’s Salary Order 1967 is hereby revoked.
