Title.

AN ACT to amend the Public Revenues Acts.

[17th September, 1890.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Public Revenues Acts Amendment Act, 1890."

Subsection 3 of section 9 of "Public Revenues Act, 1882," amended.

2. Subsection three of section nine of "The Public Revenues Act, 1882," shall take effect as if the words "the Government Insurance Commissioner and the Public Trustee" had been originally inserted in the said subsection after the words "the Colonial Treasurer."

Section 9 of "Public Revenues Act, 1886," amended.

3. Section nine of "The Public Revenues Act, 1886," shall be construed and take effect as if the words "by order or by appointment of the Governor or the Governor in Council under any statute, or otherwise howsoever," had been originally enacted in the said section, in lieu of the words "by order of the Governor under the provisions of any such Act."

All charges made under the authority of any Order in Council issued under "The Public Revenues Act, 1886," against any local body whose accounts have been or shall be audited by the Audit Office shall be payable by such local body.
