Title.

AN ACT to amend the Rating Act, 1908.

[6th November, 1924.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Rating Amendment Act, 1924, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rating Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Lands used for purposes of Sunday schools to be exempt from rates

2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (c) of the definition of the term "rateable property," the following paragraph:—

“(cc.) Lands and buildings used for the purposes of a Sunday school at which religious education is given to children and young persons, and not used for pecuniary gain or profit.”
