AN ACT to amend "The Railways Construction and Land Act, 1881." Title.
[16th September, 1890.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to give to companies formed under the provisions of "The Railways Construction and Land Act, 1881" (hereinafter termed "the said Act"), and which have already constructed or shall hereafter construct or be engaged in constructing any railway under contract made and entered into pursuant to the said Act, the power hereinafter contained: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Railways Construction and Land Act, 1890." Short Title.

2. Every company formed under the provisions of the said Act which shall have already constructed or shall hereafter construct, or shall be engaged in constructing, a railway under contract made and entered into pursuant to the provisions of the said Act, is hereby empowered and authorised to exercise for the purposes of such railway the following power, that is to say: Every company formed under the said Act may take additional land for railway purposes.

If it shall be proved to the satisfaction of the Governor that it is necessary or desirable for the use, convenience, or enjoyment of such railway to take any land in addition to land previously taken for the purposes of such railway, the Governor may, by Order in Council, authorise the company at any time, and from time to time, to take any such land in the like manner as is provided by the said Act for taking land.

3. The provisions of the sections respectively numbered from twenty-nine to thirty-three, both inclusive, of the said Act shall apply to land taken under the power and authority given by this Act. Sections 29 to 33 of said Act to apply to land taken under this Act.
