An Act to amend the Radiation Protection Act 1965

[8 November 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Radiation Protection Amendment Act 1974, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Radiation Protection Act 1965 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Commencement of principal Act—(1) Section 1 of the principal Act is hereby amended as from its passing by omitting from subsection (2) the word “Proclamation”, and substituting the words “Order in Council”.

(2) The Radiation Protection Act Commencement Order 1973 shall be deemed to be, and on and after the 5th day of March 1973 to have been, valid and effective.

3. Consequential validation of regulations—The Radiation Protection Regulations 1973 and the Transport of Radioactive Materials Regulations 1973 shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1973.
