Title.	AN ACT to extend the Duration of the Law relating to the Restriction of Rent. [31st July, 1929.]
	BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
Short Title.	1. This Act may be cited as the Rent Restriction Continuance Act, 1929.
Extension of duration of law as to restriction of rent until 1st August, 1930.	2. (1) Part I of the War Legislation Amendment Act, 1916, and the several amendments thereof, in so far as those enactments are now in force, shall continue in force until the first day of August, nineteen hundred and thirty, and shall then be deemed to be repealed.
Repeal.	(2) Section five of the Finance Act, 1928 (First Session, Twenty-third Parliament), is hereby repealed.
