**An Act to amend the Tramways Act 1908**

[31 March 1988

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Tramways Amendment Act 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tramways Act 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1988.

**2. Interpretation**—Section 2 (1) of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the definition of the term “local authority”, the following definition:

“ ‘Minister’ means the Minister of Transport:”.

**3. Board of Control to make regulations as to use of electricity**—Section 7 (6) of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words “of Works and Development”.

**4. Electric-tram drivers' certificates**—Section 2 (11) of the Tramways Amendment Act 1910 is hereby repealed.

**5. Licensing of cars**—Section 11 (1) of the Tramways Amendment Act 1910 is hereby amended by omitting from the proviso (as added by section 5 of the Tramways Amendment Act 1913) the words “Ministry of Works and Development”, and substituting the words “Ministry of Transport”.
