An Act to amend the Town and Country Planning Act 1977

[16 December 1988]

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Town and Country Planning Amendment Act (No. 2) 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Town and Country Planning Act 1977 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Constitution of Planning Tribunal—(1) Section 131 (2A) of the principal Act (as inserted by section 17 (3) of the Town and Country Planning Amendment Act 1983) is hereby amended by omitting the words “executive committees of the Municipal Association of New Zealand Incorporated, of the New Zealand Counties Association Incorporated, and of”, and substituting the words “New Zealand Local Government Association Incorporated and”.

(2) Nothing in subsection (1) of this section affects any appointment made, before the commencement of this section, under section 131 (1) (b) of the principal Act.
