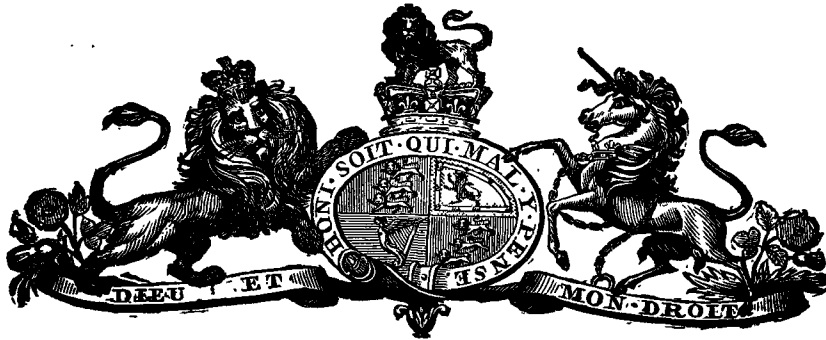

AN ACT to amend "The Census Act, 1858," and the several Acts amending the same. Title.

[2nd October, 1873.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Census Acts Amendment Act, 1873." Short Title.

2. In the construction of this Act, the expression "the said Acts" shall mean "The Census Act, 1858, "The Census Act Amendment Act, 1860," The Census Acts Amendment Act, 1867," and "The Census Acts Amendment Act, 1870." Construction.

3. The general account or census provided to be taken by "The Census Act, 1858," as amended by the said Acts, may, instead of being taken in and for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, be taken in such month and on such day or days in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, not being later than the month of April, as the Governor in Council shall, by Proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, appoint; and all the provisions of the said Acts and this Act shall, subject to this Act, apply to the account or census to be then taken, and to the time or times at which the same shall be taken. General census to be taken in such month in the year 1874 as Governor in Council may appoint.
