An Act to amend the Tourist Hotel Corporation Act 1974 relating to the Corporation's powers to hold licences and permits under the Sale of Liquor Act 1962

[9 December 1982

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Tourist Hotel Corporation Amendment Act 1982, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tourist Hotel Corporation Act 1974 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Powers of Corporation relating to liquor licences — Section 7 (2) of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing paragraphs (k) and (l), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(k) Acquire and hold, in accordance with this Act, any hotel premises licence, tourist-house premises licence, hotelkeeper’s licence, tourist-house keeper’s licence, food and entertainment licence, ship licence, booth licence, special dining permit, extended hours permit, special permit for social

gatherings, family lounge bar permit, or caterer's permit within the meaning of the Sale of Liquor Act 1962, in respect of any premises or vessel of the Corporation, and sell or dispose of liquor pursuant to any such licence or permit held by it:".

3. Special powers relating to sale of liquor at Wairakei—(1) The principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after section 7, the following section:

"7A. (1) Notwithstanding anything in the Sale of Liquor Act 1962, the Corporation may acquire and hold a club licence within the meaning of that Act in respect of any clubhouse for the time being erected on the golf course, known as the Wairakei International Golf Course and situated at State Highway 1, Wairakei, and sell or dispose of liquor pursuant to any such licence held by it.

"(2) The provisions of the Sale of Liquor Act 1962 relating to club licences, so far as they are applicable and with the necessary modifications, shall apply to any club licence held by the Corporation pursuant to subsection (1) of this section as if—

"(a) The Corporation were a club; and

"(b) The persons playing golf on the said course on any particular day were, on that day, members of the club."

(2) Subsection (1) of this section shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1981 (being the date of the commencement of the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 1980).
