AN ACT to amend "The Marriage Act 1854." [10th October 1867.] Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Marriage Act Amendment Act 1867." Short Title.

2. In the Schedule marked D. annexed to "The Marriage Act 1854" after the words "The Free Church of Scotland" there shall be inserted the following words "The Presbyterian Church of Otago and Southland" and "The Marriage Act 1854 and "The Marriage Act Amendment Act 1858" shall be read and construed as if such last mentioned words were inserted therein accordingly. Schedule D. to Marriage Act 1854 amended.
