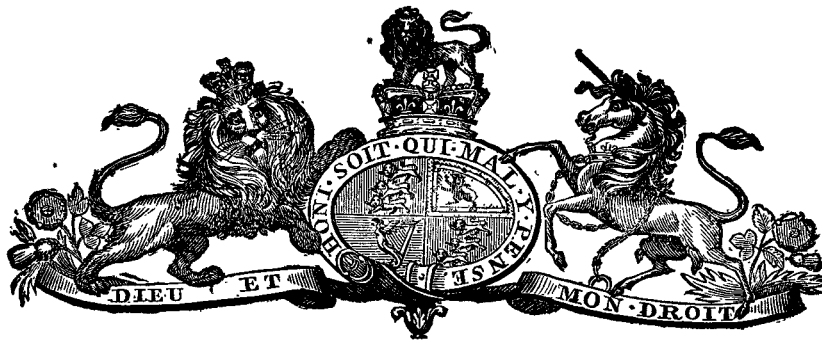

AN ACT to amend "The Crown Lands (Nelson) Leasing Act, 1871." [25th October, 1872.] Title.

WHEREAS an Act was passed by the General Assembly of New Zealand intituled "The Nelson Crown Lands Leasing Act Amendment Act, 1871." And whereas it is expedient that the said Act should be amended: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Nelson Crown Lands Leasing Act Amendment Act, 1872." Short Title.

2. All that portion of clause four of "The Nelson Crown Lands Leasing Act Amendment Act, 1871," after the word "person" in the twelfth line, and ending with the word "auction" in the fourteenth line, is hereby repealed: Provided that the minimum price of such land shall not be less than seven shillings per acre. Part of clause 4 repealed.
