

- 2. Superintendent may proclaim settlements between Catlin's River and Waikawa and also at Stewart's Island.
- 3. Settlements to be held under "The Otago Settlements Act 1869."

AN ACT to enable the Superintendent of the Province of Otago to set apart additional Lands for Settlements for Colonization in the said Province.

[14th November 1871.]

WHEREAS it is desirable that certain additional lands within the boundaries of Catlin's River and Waikawa and at Stewart's Island in the said Province of Otago be set apart for special settlements under the provisions of "The Otago Settlements Act 1869"

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Otago Settlements Act 1871."

2. The Superintendent of the Province of Otago with the advice and consent of the Executive Council thereof may at any time hereafter by Proclamation in the Gazette of the said Province set apart in addition to the lands specified in "The Otago Settlements Act 1869" one hundred thousand acres of land within the boundaries of Catlin's River and Waikawa and one hundred thousand acres in Stewart's Island in the said Province as eligible sites for settlements for colonization subject to the reservation of all existing rights and interests legal or equitable.

3. Within each of the settlements so constituted the lands set apart for the same respectively shall be held and disposed of under the provisions of "The Otago Settlements Act 1869" and not otherwise.
