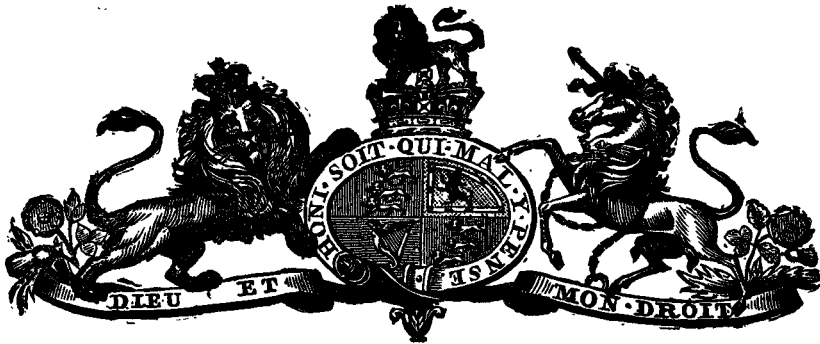

2. Amendment of "The Wellington Hospital Loan Act 1874 Amendment Act, 1875."

AN ACT to amend an Act passed in the present Session Title.
 of the General Assembly, the Short Title whereof
 is "The Wellington Hospital Loan Act 1874
 Amendment Act, 1875." [21st October, 1875.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Wellington Hospital Short Title.
 Loan Act 1874 Amendment Act, 1875 (No. 2)."

2. "The Wellington Hospital Loan Act 1874 Amendment Act, Amendment of "The
 Wellington Hospital
 Loan Act 1874
 Amendment Act,
 1875."
 1875," shall be read and construed as if on the day when the said
 Act was assented to by the Governor on behalf of Her Majesty, the
 following section had been inserted at the end of the said Act, that is
 to say:—

"Any person or persons in whom any land, which the Trustees
 aforesaid may deem it necessary to acquire for the purpose of such
 road or roads as aforesaid, is vested for any estate or interest whatso-
 ever upon any trust, and whether the person or persons in whom the
 same is vested is or is not empowered to sell the same, may sell and
 convey the same to the Trustees aforesaid, for the purpose of such road
 or roads, for such price in money as such person or persons shall think
 reasonable; and the money received by such person or persons in
 payment for any such land shall be held by such person or persons
 upon trust to invest the same either in the purchase of other land in
 the Province of Wellington, to be held by him or them upon the like
 trusts and for the like purposes as the land sold and conveyed for the
 purpose of such road or roads, or in mortgage of freehold land in the
 Province of Wellington, or in the securities of the Government of
 New Zealand."
