An Act to amend the Universities Act 1961

[12 October 1977]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Universities Amendment Act 1977, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Universities Act 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Appointment of Chairman—Section 5 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (1), and substituting the following subsection:

“(1) The Chairman of the University Grants Committee shall be appointed by the Governor-General after consultation between the Minister, the Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor of each of the Universities other than Lincoln College, and the Chairman of Council and Principal of Lincoln College.”

3. Appointment of other members—Section 6 (1) of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing paragraphs (a) and (b), and substituting the following paragraphs:

- “(a) The Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor of each of the Universities other than Lincoln College; and
“(b) The Chairman of Council and Principal of Lincoln College.”

4. Constitution of Curriculum Committee—Section 27 (3) of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the expression “(other than the members appointed under paragraph (e) of subsection (2) of this section)”.

5. Passing of resolutions of Curriculum Committee without a meeting—Section 29 (2) of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from the second proviso the expression “(other than a member appointed under paragraph (e) of subsection (2) of section 27 of this Act)”.

6. Constitution of Research Committee—Section 33 (2) (c) of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the word “Five”, and substituting the word “Seven”.

This Act is administered in the University Grants Committee.
