**An Act to amend the Workers' Compensation Act 1956**

[13 January 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Workers' Compensation Amendment Act 1980, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Workers' Compensation Act 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1981.

**2. Appointment of Judge**—(1) Section 41 (5) of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the word "seventy-two", and substituting the expression "68".

(2) Notwithstanding anything in section 41 (5) of the principal Act or in subsection (1) of this section, the Judge in office at the commencement of this section may, at his option, continue in office until he attains the age of 72 years.
