The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Wellington City Council (Te Aro Reclamation) Amendment Act 2004.
- (2) In this Act, the Act that was previously called the Te Aro Reclamation Act 1879 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 Name of principal Act changed

- (1) After the commencement of this Act, the principal Act is called the Wellington City Council (Te Aro Reclamation) Act 1879.
- (2) The Short Title of the principal Act is consequentially amended by omitting the words “Te Aro Reclamation”, and substituting the words “Wellington City Council (Te Aro Reclamation)”.
- (3) Every reference in any enactment or in any document to the Te Aro Reclamation Act 1879 is consequentially amended by

omitting the words “Te Aro Reclamation”, and substituting the words “Wellington City Council (Te Aro Reclamation)”.

4 New section 8 substituted

The principal Act is amended by repealing sections 8 and 9, and substituting the following section:

“8 Council has power to deal with reclaimed land

- “(1) The Council has the power to deal with any reclaimed land or any part of it, for example, by selling or leasing it.
- “(2) The power referred to in subsection (1) must be exercised under, and in accordance with, section 12 of the Local Government Act 2002.
- “(3) For the purposes of subsection (1), **reclaimed land** means any land that is reclaimed under this Act.”
