

AN ACT to authorize the Municipal Corporation of Wellington to deal with Land belonging to them. Title.

[31st October, 1876.]

**W**HEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Wellington are possessed of certain land, and it is expedient to enable them to deal with the same in manner hereinafter mentioned, subject and without prejudice nevertheless to any special trusts affecting the same: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Wellington Corporate Land Act, 1876.” Short Title.

2. The land described in the Schedule to this Act shall, in addition to any other lands now vested in the Corporation in fee-simple, be deemed to be vested in the Corporation in fee-simple. Land in Schedule hereto vested in Corporation.

3. The Corporation may dispose of, either by way of sale or exchange for other hereditaments situate within the said city, the land described in the Schedule to this Act, upon such terms and conditions as they shall think fit, and may apply all or any of the money received by them upon any such sale, or by way of equality or exchange, in such manner for the benefit of the said city as they shall think fit and Corporation may dispose of land described in Schedule.
