| Title. | AN ACT to amend the Law with respect to the Capacity of Women to sit in Parliament. [29th October, 1919.] |
| Short Title. | BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:— 1. This Act may be cited as the Women's Parliamentary Rights Act, 1919. |
| Capacity of women to become members of Parliament. | 2. A woman shall not be disqualified by sex or marriage from being elected as a member of the House of Representatives, or from sitting or voting as a member thereof, anything to the contrary in the Legislature Act, 1908, or in any other Act notwithstanding. |
