1976, No. 11—*Local*

An Act to amend the Wellington Regional Water Board Act 1972 [17 January 1977]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Wellington Regional Water Board Amendment Act 1976, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wellington Regional Water Board Act 1972 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Chairman's allowance—(1) Section 15 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (1), and substituting the following subsection:

“(1) The Chairman may be paid, out of the funds of the Board, such annual allowance as may from time to time be fixed by the Board with the approval of the Minister of Finance.”

(2) The said section 15 is hereby further amended by repealing subsection (2).

3. Allowances to members—Section 19 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (2), and substituting the following subsections:

“(2) In addition to the allowances authorised by subsection (1) of this section, there may be paid, out of the Board’s funds, to each member of the Board, other than the Chairman, in respect of each meeting of the Board or of any committee of the Board attended by him, remuneration at a rate fixed by the Board, not exceeding such amount as may be fixed from time to time by the Minister of Finance:

“Provided that the maximum amount paid to any member of the Board under this subsection shall not exceed, in any financial year, such amount as may be fixed from time to time by the Minister of Finance.

“(3) The Minister of Finance may fix different amounts under subsection (2) of this section in respect of different specified categories of members and different specified classes of committees.”

4. Power to acquire land and erect dwellings for employees—(1) Section 24 (1) (g) of the principal Act is hereby amended—

(a) By inserting, after the word “erect”, the words “, alter, or enlarge”:

(b) By inserting, after the words “erected thereon,”, the words “or to enable him to repay or refinance a mortgage of any such land,”.

(2) This section shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of December 1972.

5. Audit of accounts—Section 100 of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:

“(2) The Board’s accounts in respect of each financial year shall be submitted to the Audit Office for audit before the 30th day of September next following that year.”
