AN ACT to vest a Certain Reserve at Wyndham in Trustees for the  
Mataura Pastoral and Agricultural Society. Title.

[30th July, 1886.]

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule to this Act was, by  
an Executive minute of the Provincial Government of Otago, on  
the nineteenth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and  
seventy-six, set aside as a Show-ground for the Mataura Pastoral  
and Agricultural Society: And whereas a Bill was passed in  
the Legislative Council in the second session of the sixth Parlia-  
ment of New Zealand, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-  
seven, which provided that the said land should vest in trustees in  
trust for the purposes for which the said society was formed: And  
whereas the said Bill lapsed in the House of Representatives: And  
whereas in the same session of the General Assembly a Bill of similar  
intent was passed in the House of Representatives, but lapsed in the  
Legislative Council: And whereas the said land has been occupied  
and used as a show-ground by the said society since one thousand  
eight hundred and seventy-six: And whereas a *Gazette* notice dated  
May, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, purports to vest the  
said land in the Town Board of Wyndham: And whereas the  
Mataura Pastoral and Agricultural Society is equitably entitled to  
continue in possession of the said land and to obtain a clear title  
thereto: It is expedient to vest the said land and the management  
thereof in the trustees named in this Act in trust for the purposes for  
which the society was formed. Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New  
Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Wyndham Show-ground  
Reserve Act, 1886.” Short Title.

2. The land described in the Schedule to this Act shall be and  
the same is hereby vested in the trustees hereinafter named in trust Land vested in  
trust.

for the Mataura Pastoral and Agricultural Society and for the purposes for which the said society was formed.

Trustees.

3. The trustees to the said land shall be James Forsyth, Edendale; George Frederick Richardson, Oaklands; James Milne, Oware; Donald Stalker, Redan; Edward Anderson, Glenham; James Alexander Robertson Menzies, Dun Alister: and the said trustees, by the name of "The Wyndham Show-ground Reserve Trust," shall be a body corporate, and may do and suffer all things that bodies corporate may do and suffer.

Management by trust.

4. The said Trust shall manage the said lands in all respects as to the said Trust may seem expedient, but so that the lands shall be used for the purposes for which they have by this Act been set apart; and any rents or revenue the said Trust shall receive shall be expended on the said lands: Provided always that the said Trust may for seven days in a year close the said reserve to the public and charge for admission to such reserve on such days.

Disqualification.

5. If any of the members of the said Trust shall die, or shall become bankrupt, or take the advantage of any law for the relief of insolvent debtors, or be convicted of any felony, or be absent from the Provincial District of Otago for nine months, then in any of the said cases such member shall cease to be a member of the said Trust. And the Governor may, in any such case, or in case any member resigns his membership, appoint another or others in his place.

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Otago, containing by admeasurement 5 acres, more or less, being Section No. 2, Block VI., on the record-map of the Town of Wyndham, deposited in the Survey Office, Dunedin.
