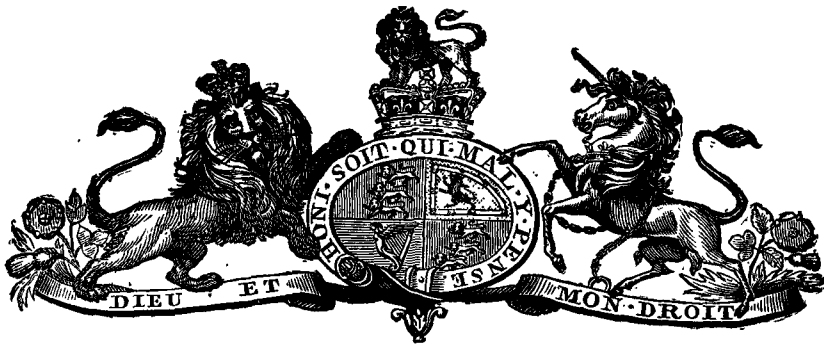

AN ACT to amend the Regulations for the Sale Letting Title.  
and Disposal of Waste Lands in the Province of  
Wellington. [12th September 1870.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in  
Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as  
follows—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Wellington Waste Short Title.  
Lands Act 1870.”

2. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent of the Province of Superintendent may  
set aside a block of  
land for special  
settlement.  
Wellington with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council to  
set aside out of the Waste Lands within the Province of Wellington  
the Native title of which has been extinguished any block or blocks  
for the purpose of special settlement on such terms as may be  
sanctioned by the Governor in Council anything in the existing  
regulations for the management or disposal of the Waste Lands in the  
Province to the contrary notwithstanding Provided always that no  
land shall be sold at a less price than land of a similar description is  
now sold under the regulations aforesaid and that the proceeds thereof  
shall be subject to any lien already imposed thereon by any Act of the  
General Assembly.

3. On the expiration of any existing occupation license it shall Land Commissioner  
may renew and issue  
fresh occupation  
licenses.  
be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands of the Province of  
Wellington to renew or regrant such license for a further term of  
seven years to the late holder thereof if he shall desire the same

and if he declines or neglects to apply in writing for the renewal of such license then to grant occupation license of the land comprised therein or any part thereof to any other person for a like term of seven years subject in either case to the existing Land Regulations in force in the said Province except as hereby modified and at such yearly sum as may be sanctioned by the Provincial Council of the said Province Provided always that such yearly sum shall in no case be less than twopence per acre.
