A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Armed Constabulary Act, 1867."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Armed Constabulary Act 1867 Amendment Act, 1884." Short Title.

2. So much of section twenty-six of "The Armed Constabulary Act, 1867," as prohibits any Commandant, Inspector, Sub-Inspector, or other officer, or any constable, during the time he shall continue in the Armed Constabulary, from voting for the election of a member of the General Assembly, is hereby repealed. Armed Constabulary may exercise franchise.
