A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT for the Total Abolition of Imprisonment for Title. Debt.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Abolition of Imprison- short Title. 5 ment for Debt Act, 1879."

2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of January, Commencing one thousand eight hundred and eighty, from which date "The operation of Act. Imprisonment for Debt Abolition Act, 1874," and "The Imprisonment Repeal. for Debt Abolition Act Amendment Act, 1875," shall be repealed.

3. Henceforth no person shall be imprisoned for debt.

4. The following shall be deemed indictable offences punishable Indictable offences by fine or by imprisonment, with or without hard labour, for any term punishable by fine or imprisonment. not exceeding twelve months :-

(1.) Any person who, with intent to defraud, shall by any device or promise induce credit to be given.

- (2.) Any person who, by any false representation or by any concealment of property which might be taken in execution, shall have prevented or delayed the execution of any distress warrant or writ of *fieri facias* issued by any Court of competent jurisdiction upon a judgment available against such person.
- (3.) Any person who shall have made default in payment of any sum or sums of money received in a fiduciary or professional capacity, and which shall have been ordered to be paid by a Court of competent jurisdiction.
