## A BILL INTITULED

- AN ACT to provide that the Judges of the Supreme Court shall Title. henceforth be appointed for the Term of Five Years, and no longer.
- **5** BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Supreme Court Act 1882 short Title. Amendment Act, 1884."

2. From and after the passing of this Act all appointments of a Appointment of 10 Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Colony of New Zealand, Judges and duration of office. and of any Judge or Judges of the said Court, shall be made by a Commission under the Great Seal of the Colony for a period of five years, when such appointment shall cease and determine, and a new appointment for a like term of five years shall be made of a Chief 15 Justice or Judge to fill the vacancy which shall have taken place.

3. No Chief Justice or Judge appointed under the authority of No superannuation this Act shall have any claim to any superannuation allowance.
