A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to enable the Hours of Daylight to be more fully utilised. Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Alteration of Time Act, 1908. Short Title.

2. At midnight of the last Saturday in the month of September
5 in each year standard time of New Zealand shall be set forward one
hour; at midnight of the last Saturday in the month of March in
each year standard time shall be set back one hour. Alteration of time.

3. Nothing in this Act shall affect New Zealand mean time as
used for astronomical or nautical purposes. Not to affect time for astronomical or nautical purposes.
