### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to establish Annual Parliaments.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Annual Parliaments Act, 1881."

Short Title.

10 2. Notwithstanding anything in any former Act or law contained, every future House of Representatives shall, unless the General Assembly be sooner dissolved, continue for a period of one year only, to be computed from the day fixed for the return of the writs issued for choosing such House, and no longer.
