Title. Preamble. 1. Short Title.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to Repeal The Turnpike Acts, 1866, of The the Auckland Provincial Legislature.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the turnpike system of levying Preamble. tolls in the Auckland Provincial District should be abolished:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Auckland Turnpike Acts short Title. Repeal Act, 1879."

2. From and after the first day of January, one thousand eight Repeal. hundred and eighty, "The Turnpike Act, 1866," and "The Turn-10 pike Act 1866 Amendment Act, 1866," shall be repealed.

3. Nothing in this Act contained shall be held to invalidate saving. or affect any existing contracts entered into under the repealed Acts.
