A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to exclude the Mangere Riding of the County of Manukau from the Auckland Transport District. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Auckland Transport District (Mangere Riding Exclusion) Act 1954. Short Title.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the term "Auckland Transport District" means the district of the Auckland Transport Board as now constituted under the Auckland Transport Board Act 1928; and the term "Mangere Riding" means the Riding of that name as now constituted and forming part of the County of Manukau. Interpretation.

3. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Auckland Transport Board Act 1928, or in any Proclamation heretofore made thereunder, or in the Local Government Commission Act 1953 or any other Act, the Mangere Riding of the County of Manukau is hereby excluded from the Auckland Transport District, and is hereby declared to have been so excluded as on and from the thirtieth day of March nineteen hundred and fifty-four. 5

Cancelling

4. The Manukau County Council shall not be liable to pay to the Auckland Transport Board any portion of any levy made by that Board since the thirtieth day of March, nineteen hundred and fifty-four. 10

Saving.

5. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to prevent the said Riding or any part thereof from being hereafter included by process of law in the Auckland Transport District. 15
