A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to regulate the Manufacture, Sale, and Export of Butter. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Butter Export Act, 1907, and shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Dairy Industry Act, 1898. Short Title.

10 2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and *eight*. Commencement.

3. Any person who sells, offers for sale, has in his possession for sale, manufactures for sale, exports, or attempts to export any butter which contains more than sixteen per cent. of water commits Limit of water in butter.  
15 an offence and is liable to a fine not exceeding *fifty* pounds.
