A BILL INTITULED

An Act to regulate the Export of Butter.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Butter Export Act, 1907, and Short Title. shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Dairy Industry Act, 1898.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of Commencement.

10 January, nineteen hundred and eight.

3. Any person who exports or attempts to export any butter Limit of water in which contains more than sixteen per cent. of water commits an offence and is liable to a fine not exceeding *fifty* pounds.
