BUILDING EMERGENCY REGULATIONS AMENDMENT BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill extends the duration of the Building Emergency Regulations Act 1953 for one year, to the end of 1955.

This will have the effect of continuing in force for the same period the existing regulations in force under the Act, namely, the Building Emergency Regulations 1939 and their amendments and the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939 and their amendments. The latter regulations make general provisions that are necessary to give full effect to the Building Emergency Regulations.
